*Today we're interviewing Núria, the teacher responsible for Agenda 21 at our school.*

## **Who are you?**

I am Núria, teacher of Biology and Geology and responsible for agenda 21 in Maria Rúbies school.

## **What are your goals?**

We have 2 objectives:

1. One is the sustainable management of the high school(selective collection, participation into environment actions...)
2. Get the information of the students and their learning, for example this academic year we have bought the containers but seventh-year students have designed the labels while they learn.

## **Does the school participate in Agenda 21 Escolar of LLeida?**

The high school Maria Rubies has been involved since the 2006-2007 academic year in Agenda 21 for schools. From the beginning the high school Maria Rubies has assumed his part of responsibility to achieve a more sustainable high school.

## **What activities have been done and shared with other schools in the Micro-network?**

All the centers that have participated in the waste prevention micro-network as a first task made a plan of the center where they placed the different fractions of waste that were collected in the center. After that our shool decided that we would quantify the fraction of disposable packaging (aluminum foil, tetrabrics...) and reusable wrappers that are generated in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd yards.

## **What are the key principles of Agenda 21?**

Agenda 21 has the objective of making society more sustainable. Although we can now change its name as we are talking about the 2030 agenda and the SDGs. The main goal is to keep the planet **in shape** so as not to compromise the future of future generations.

### **What countries participate in l'Agenda 21?**

The first summit of the agenda 21 was created in the 1992 to Río de Janeiro since then they have been holding new summits and i have been incorporated new contris. But presently the ONU was established agenda 21 to 2030 with 17 new objectives of sustainable development amb the most important is that the last April the spanish parliament established the new law on climate change and energy transition. For example, one of the goals is that by 2030, 45% of energy will come from renewable energy.
